### **WASTE WATER DISCHARGE TO RAINWATER DRAINAGE SYSTEM**

We observed that residents have placed washing machines at the private enclosed space (PES) / balcony of their units.

The M&E consultant had advised that the drainage system at the PES and balconies are for **RAINWATER DISCHARGE** to the open drain. **The waste water discharge (dirty water) from washing machine and/or basin/sink must be discharged to the sanitary sewer system to prevent pollution to the rainwater recycling system.** Reference from Code of Practice on Sewage and Sanitary Works (Part 3) Clause 3.1.2(a):

“Sanitary System shall convey only wastewater from within the premises to the sewage system. Rainwater shall not be discharge into sanitary drainage system.”

M/s PUB Water Supply Publication informed that rainwater flows into the rainwater discharge system and eventually into the reservoirs to form our water supply. Dirty water goes into sewers and is channeled to water reclamation plants for treatment. It is important to discharge used water into sewers so that our water supply source stays clean.

We seek your co-operation on the above to keep our waterways clean and beautiful for all to enjoy!
