PREVENTION OF MOSQUITOES BREEDING HABITATS

The Management had received a feedback from a resident, that items such as pails and containers are being placed on the aircon compressor ledge (particularly in Tower 15 and 17). In view of the current Zika epidemic, the Management is seeking your co-operation to refrain from placing any items on the ledge as the weather has been unpredictable lately with high soaring temperature accompanied with occasional rain. With the threat of Zika virus, it is even more critical to reduce the mosquito population. Moving forward, we would also like to encourage all residents to carry out the "Mozzie Wipeout" in your premises.

1. Change water in vases /bowls on alternate days
2. Remove water from flower pots / plates on alternate days
3. Turn over all water storage containers and receptacles
4. Get rid of any stagnant water, eg floor traps, air con trays and discarded items in balcony and toilets
5. If you are going overseas, do ensure that all gully traps, floor traps and toilet bowls are covered and apply sand granular insecticide when needed



There are some common breeding habitats as identified by NEA as follows:

- a. Domestic containers and rims
- b. Flower pot plates / trays / planter boxes
- c. Vases / plant bowls / watering cans
- d. Canvas sheet / plastic sheet
- e. Dish rack trays

The Management will continue to ensure that licensed pest control operators conduct weekly source reduction of mosquito breeding and to carry out the necessary treatment within the Condominium compounds. We would also encourage everyone to play your part in protecting yourself and your loved ones; to be aware of the dangers, to act responsibly and to advocate actions to prevent mosquito breeding in your homes.
