PARKING OF NON-REGISTERED / PUBLIC SHARING BIKES

1. It was observed that many bicycles are parking haphazardly and obstructing vehicles' parking lots, especially at Blk 5 level 1. All residents are reminded to register your personal bikes with the Management Office for a Q Bay bicycle tagging and park them appropriately at the designated bicycle lots only. More bicycle lots are available at Basement 2 car park.
2. We have also received feedback from residents and observed from the media about the anti-social behaviors displayed by users of the bike-sharing scheme (eg. OFO, oBike and Mobike). These PUBLIC-SHARING BIKES have been left at common areas and outside the estate boundary by the users. **Please be informed that our bicycle lots are limited and reserved for residents' REGISTERED bikes only.** Users of public-sharing bike scheme must understand that parking these public bikes indiscriminately are causing obstruction to others. It may also endanger the lives of others if contravene SCDF guidelines.

Where to park a bike?

1. The bike should be returned in the designated public bike parking area or bike parking coil.
2. Please don't park it in a private place, where others can't find it. It would be good if you can return the bike to an area designated public bike parking area.



Kindly note that residents are **NOT** allowed to bring in these public-sharing bikes beyond the entrance of Q Bay Residences. Thank you.
